every executive authority is bound to advance reasoning in support of his order as held by the august Supreme Court of Pakistan in the case reported as M/s Airport Support Services v. The Airport Manager, Quaid-e-Azam International Airport, Karachi and others (1998 SCMR 2268).

Consequently, instant petition is **accepted**, letter dated 08.06.2009 is declared to be inconsequential and the matter is remitted back to the Auditor General of Pakistan, for decision afresh on the application of the petitioner through a well-reasoned order after attending to the provisions of Auditor-General's Manual of Standing Orders, Third Edition, in particular Para No.155 thereof.
