UP-GRADATION OF POSTS ALONGWITH INCUMBENTS IN DEPARTMENTAL CADRE IN THE CONTROLLER GENERAL OF ACCOUNTS ORGANIZATION.

It is stated that District Accounts Offices through out the country are manned by Federal Government (CGA/AGs) and Provincial Government (Finance Deptt) at the ratio of 50:50 while having the same functions. The Finance Department, Govt; of Punjab vide Notification No.SO (B &E-I)7-1/2003 dated 12-09-2005 (copy enclosed) upgraded their posts along-with incumbents as per following details:

- O2. Following the above up-gradation by Govt; of Punjab, the Govt; of NWFP, Sindh and Balochistan also carried out the up-gradation of their staff posted in District Accounts Offices while the employees of Federal Government (CGA/AGs) remained the same which created anomaly and discrimination. Resultantly, the representatives of AGs/CGA lodged their appeals in the FST and tic case was decided in their favour on 05-12-2008 (copy enclosed) wherein the Finance Division/CGA/ were directed to implement the same. In response to the FST verdict, the CGA/AGP, through Finance Division conveyed their inability to implement the same due to constrains of structural limitation (copy enclosed). After wards the petitioner again lodged their complained 13 the FST for non-implementation of the earlier decision and FST finally passed its verdict dafed 19-12-2009 and strictly directed the respondents to implement its decision within 90 days (copy enclosed).
- O3. Consequently the Finance Division/CGA filed CPLA in the Supreme Court for review of FST verdict (copy enclosed). The apex court while having pre-admission hearing on 15-03-2010, dismissed the CPLA and directed the Finance Division CGA/AG Punjab to implement the FST verdict dated 05-12-2008 within 15 days and compliance report be sent to the Registrar of the Supreme Court for their perusal in chamber.
- O4. Keeping in New the above position and to implement the Honorable Supreme Courts directives and advice of Finance Division bearing No. U.O. No. F.9/R-1/2008 dated 26-03-2010 (copy enclosed), the CGA being head of the department recommends the up-gradation of posts along-with the incumbents in CGA Organization as per following detail:-

District Accounts Offices through out the country are manned by Federal Government (Controller General of Accounts/Accountants General) and Provincial Government (Finance Department) in the ratio of 50:50. The Finance Department, Government of Punjab vide Notification No. SO (B &E-I)7-1/2003 dated 12-09-2005 (Annex A) upgraded their posts as per following details:

- Pollowing the above up-gradation by Government of Punjab; he Governments of NWFP, Sindh and Balochistan also carried out the up-gradation of their staff posted in District Accounts Offices while the status of posts of Federal Government (Controller General of Accounts/Accountants General) remained the same which created an anomaly. Resultantly, the representatives of Accountant, General Punjab & NWFP lodged appeals in the Federal Service Tribunal and the case was decided in their favour on 05-12-2008 (Annex B) wherein the Figurace Division/Controller General of Accounts were directed to decide the issue of upgradation within 90 days. In response to the Federal Service Tribunal verdict, the Finance Division in consultation with Establishment Division conveyed their inability to implement the same due to its implications on service structure (Annex C & D). Afterwards the appellants again went to Federal Service Tribunal against non-implementation of its earlier decision. Federal Service Tribunal finally passed its verdict dated 19-12-2009 and strictly directed the respondents to implement its decision within 90 days (Annex E).
 - O3. Consequently the Finance Division/Controller General of Accounts filed CPLA in the Supreme Court (Annex F). The apex court dismissed the petitions on 15-03-2010 and directed the Finance Division, Controller General of Accounts and Accountant General Punjab to implement the Federal Service Tribunal verdict dated 05-12-2008 within 15 days and compliance report be sent to the Registrar of the Supreme Court (Annex G).
 - Finance Division vide U.O. No. F.9/R-1/2008 dated 26-03-2010 (Annex H) has advised the Controller General of Accounts to take up the case with the Estab ishment Division for concurrence of upgradation of posts for implementation of Supreme Court order.

In order to it plement the orders of the Honorable Supreme Court of Pakistan, it is sested to upgrade all positions in the following grades under the Controller General of Accounts:-

UP-GRADATION OF THE POST OF AUDITOR SALES TAX FROM BS-14 TO BS-16 AS SENIOR AUDITOR.

The Auditors (BS-14) working in the Sales Tax Department (FBR) have been making requests for up-gradation of their post for the past few years. The matter was taken up with the Establishment Division for consideration for up-gradation of the post of Auditor from BS-14 to BS-15 vide our d.o. letter of even number dated 27th June, 2008 (Annex-I). Later on, FBR also moved a Note for Secretary, Finance Division/Secretary, Establishment Division for up-gradation of this post from BS-14 to BS-16 (Annex-II). Now out of a blue, the Establishment Division vide their O.M.No.8/73/2007-R.I, dated 13th July, 2010 (Annex-III) has up-graded the post of Auditor from BS-14 to BS-16 as Senior Auditor subject to the concurrence of Finance Division, amendment in the Recruitment Rules and filling the up-graded posts.

- 2. It is informed that at present, 669 posts of Auditors are sanctioned in the Sales Tax Department against which 370 incumbents are working which after upgradation will be added upto the posts of Senior Auditor (BS-16) and the total number will become 728. The financial implications involved in up-gradation of these posts of Auditors will be at Rs.1,308,000/- per annum (approximately). The expenditure would be met from within the sanctioned budget grant of the Federal Board of Revenue during the current financial year.
- Finance Division is requested to concur to the up-gradation of the post of Auditor (BS-14) into Senior Auditor (BS-16) as approved by the Establishment Division and convey their approval to the Federal Board of Revenue at the earliest.
