

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

Subject:- UPGRADATION OF POSTS ALONGWITH  
INCUMBENTS IN THE PAKISTAN MILITARY  
ACCOUNTS DEPARTMENT AND PAKISTAN  
RAILWAY ACCOUNTS DEPARTMENT.

The undersigned is directed to refer to the Office of Controller General of Accounts letter No.439/Estt-III/Court/15-C/Creation of Posts/2008 dated 9<sup>th</sup> April, 2010 on the above subject. Finance Division agrees to the view point of the Office of CGA contained in their letter at para-4. However, the CGA Ordinance empowers the CGA to look after the affairs of MAG and Railway Accounts. Since the up-gradation is being made under the Court directions in the Organizations of CGA, it is therefore, requested to issue the orders of up-gradation of posts of departmentalized Accounts Offices of Pakistan Military Accounts Department and Pakistan Railway Accounts Department as have been issued by the CGA on 03-04-2010 to remove the anomaly/discrimination.

**SUMMARY FOR APPROVAL OF THE SECRETARY  
ESTABLISHMENT DIVISION**

**Subject:- UP-GRADATION OF POSTS ALONGWITH INCUMBENTS IN  
DEPARTMENTAL CADRE IN THE CONTROLLER GENERAL OF  
ACCOUNTS ORGANIZATION**

District Accounts Offices through out the country are manned by Federal Government (Controller General of Accounts/Accountants General) and Provincial Government (Finance Department) in the ratio of 50:50. The Finance Department, Government of Punjab vide Notification No. SO (B & E-I)7-1/2003 dated 12-09-2005 (Annex A) upgraded their posts as per following details:

02. Following the above up-gradation by Government of Punjab; the Governments of NWFP, Sindh and Balochistan also carried out the up-gradation of their staff posted in District Accounts Offices while the status of posts of Federal Government (Controller General of Accounts/Accountants General) remained the same which created an anomaly. Resultantly, the representatives of Accountant General Punjab & NWFP lodged appeals in the Federal Service Tribunal and the case was decided in their favour on 05-12-2008 (Annex B) wherein the Finance Division/Controller General of Accounts were directed to decide the issue of upgradation within 90 days. In response to the Federal Service Tribunal verdict, the Finance Division in consultation with Establishment Division conveyed their inability to implement the same due to its implications on service structure (Annex C & D). Afterwards the appellants again went to Federal Service Tribunal against non-implementation of its earlier decision. Federal Service Tribunal finally passed its verdict dated 19-12-2009 and strictly directed the respondents to implement its decision within 90 days (Annex E).

03. Consequently the Finance Division/Controller General of Accounts filed CPLA in the Supreme Court (Annex F). The apex court dismissed the petitions on 15-03-2010 and directed the Finance Division, Controller General of Accounts and Accountant General Punjab to implement the Federal Service Tribunal verdict dated 05-12-2008 within 15 days and compliance report be sent to the Registrar of the Supreme Court (Annex G).

04. Finance Division vide U.O. No. F.9/R-1/2008 dated 26-03-2010 (Annex H) has advised the Controller General of Accounts to take up the case with the Establishment Division for concurrence of upgradation of posts for implementation of Supreme Court order.



In order to implement the orders of the Honorable Supreme Court of Pakistan, it is requested to upgrade all posts in the following grades under the Controller General of Accounts:-

Distt Accounts Officer/Accounts Officer	BS-17	to	BS-18
Assistant Accounts Officer/Divisional Accounts Officer	BS-16	to	BS-17
Senior Auditor/Assistant Supervisor	BS-14/15	to	BS-16
Junior Auditor	BS-7	to	BS-11

In light of Establishment Division's O.M No. 8/36/200-R- dated: 20-01-2001, concurrence of the Establishment Division is requested to the proposal at para-C5 above.

It is also pointed out that on account of proposed upgradation, other departments working under the CGA such as MAG, Railway Accounts, Departmentalised and Self Accounting entities will also be effected. In order to avoid anomaly, discrimination and resultant litigations, the following posts are also proposed to be upgraded:

Accounts Officer	BPS-17	to	BPS-18
Assistant Accounts Officer/Equivalent	BPS-16	to	BPS-17
Senior Auditor/Assistant Supervisor/ Equivalent	BPS-14/15	to	BPS-16
Junior Auditor/Equivalent	BPS-7	to	BPS-11

It is further requested that the posts being held by Inter Departmental Cadre Officers BPS-17 who are senior in the same grade and are 1/4<sup>th</sup> of the total BPS-17 Officers; may also be graded to BPS-18. This upgradation would be essential to avoid anomaly in Inter Departmental Cadre (IDC) and Departmental Cadre (DC).

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


